

TO (I) ENACT AND ORDAIN AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE BRODHEAD CREEK REGIONAL AUTHORITY (THE "AUTHORITY") TO CHANGE ITS REGISTERED OFFICE, EXTEND THE TERM OF EXISTENCE OF THE AUTHORITY AND TO UPDATE THE LISTING OF CURRENT MEMBERS AND THEIR TERMS; (II) APPROVE THE EXECUTION OF A SUPPLEMENT TO THE SECOND **AMENDED** RESTATED INTERMUNICIPAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT, DATED MAY 1, 2010 AMONG THE MEMBER MUNICIPALITIES OF THE BRODHEAD CREEK REGIONAL AUTHORITY, THE AUTHORITY AND THE STROUD TOWNSHIP SEWER AUTHORITY, AND ESTABLISH THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUCH SECOND SUPPLEMENT; (III) AUTHORIZE THE DOING OF ALL THINGS NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE TO EFFECT AND ESTABLISH SAID AMENDMENT; (IV) PROVIDE FOR THE SEVERABILITY OF THE PROVISIONS OF SAID ORDINANCE; (V) REPEAL OR RESCIND ALL ORDINANCES OR RESOLUTIONS OR PARTS THEREOF WHICH ARE INCONSISTENT HEREWITH; AND (VI) ESTABLISH THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SAID ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the Brodhead Creek Regional Authority (the "Authority") is a municipal authority organized and existing under the Municipality Authorities Act (the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania approved May 2, 1945, P.L. 382, as continued by an Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania approved June 19, 2001, P.L. 22 (53 Pa. Cons. Stat. §§5601 et seq.) (the "Act") for the purpose, inter alia, of (i) construction, ownership and operation of water systems, serving the Borough of Stroudsburg and the Townships of Hamilton, Pocono, Smithfield and Stroud (collectively, the "Member Municipalities") as well as certain other non-member municipalities and users agreeing to be served thereby, (collectively with Member Municipalities the "Water Service Area Municipalities") and (ii) the acquisition, transfer, ownership, lease (as lessor or lessee), expansion, financing, permitting, construction, improvement, administration, maintenance, operation and management of one or more sewage and wastewater collection systems and treatment facilities for the benefit of certain Member Municipalities and any other municipalities and users agreeing to be served similarly; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act of December 19, 1976, P.L. 1158, No. 177, as amended, codified at 53 Pa. Cons. Stat. §§2301, et seq., provides that two or more local governments in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania may jointly cooperate in the exercise or performance of their respective governmental functions, powers or responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, Section 1502 of the First Class Township Code, found at 53 P.S. §56552 entitled "General Powers", authorizes the Board of Commissioners to make and adopt ordinances as may be deemed expedient or necessary for the proper management, care and control of the Township and its finances, and the maintenance of good government and welfare of the Township; and

WHEREAS, Section 1502 of the First Class Township Code, found at 53 P.S. §56553, entitled "Joint municipal agreements", authorizes the Board of Commissioners to enter into agreements with other political subdivisions in performing governmental powers, duties and functions, and in carrying into effect provisions of law relating to the same which are common to such political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, Section 2440 of the First Class Township Code, found at 53 P.S. §57440, entitled "Building Joint Sewers", authorizes townships, jointly with other cities, boroughs or townships, to build and construct sewers, and connect into such system, any portion of the cost of which not assessed or not assessable upon properties benefited shall be paid by the respective townships, cities and boroughs as may be agreed upon; and

WHEREAS, the governing boards of the Authority, the Member Municipalities and the Stroud Township Sewer Authority (solely in its capacity as owner and operator of the Stroud Collection System with no right, title, or interest in the governance or assets of the Authority), previously entered into an Amended and Restated Intermunicipal Cooperation Agreement dated as of May 1, 2010 (the "Amended and Restated Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the governing boards of the Authority, the Member Municipalities and the Stroud Township Sewer Authority (solely in its capacity as owner and operator of the Stroud Collection System with no right, title, or interest in the governance or assets of the Authority) also previously entered into a First Supplement to the Amended and Restated Intermunicipal Cooperation Agreement dated as of November 1, 2010 (the "First Supplement") (the Amended and Restated Agreement and the First Supplement are collectively referred to as the "Cooperation Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the first tri-annual meeting was held on April 7, 2014 between the Member Municipalities and the Collection System Owners, wherein amendments to the Cooperation Agreement were proposed and agreed upon to be codified in a Second Supplement; and

WHEREAS, the **Board of Commissioners**, pursuant to all of said authority, desires to approve and enter into the Second Supplement; and

WHEREAS, the Authority was first incorporated as the Stroudsburg Municipal Authority, on November 30, 1953, which Articles of Incorporation were amended in 1968 and 1984, both of which to extend the term of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Articles of Incorporation were further amended in 2005 by the Member Municipalities in order to convert the Authority from a single municipal authority owned by the Borough of Stroudsburg to a joint authority adding Hamilton, Pocono, Stroud, and Smithfield Townships; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Articles of Incorporation were amended again by the Member Municipalities effective May 18, 2010 ("Existing Articles"), which expanded the powers and purposes of the Authority, authorized the owning, maintaining, and operation of sewer and sewer systems, including collection and treatment plants, extended the term of existence, and set forth terms and conditions for appointment of the Authority's Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, the Member Municipalities desire to change the registered office of the Authority, extend the term of the Authority to a full fifty (50) years as authorized by the Act, as well as update the listing of current members and their terms, thereby necessitating an amendment to the Existing Articles; and

WHEREAS, the Authority adopted a Resolution on ________, 2017, proposing an amendment of its Articles of Amendment in the form attached hereto as **Exhibit A** in order to change the registered office of the Authority, extend the term of the existence of the Authority from January 1, 2060 to January 1, 2067 and update the listing of current members and their terms; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it to be in the best interests, and for the general welfare and safety, of the citizens and residents of Pocono Township to amend the Existing Articles as proposed, and to enter into the Second Supplement to the Amended and Restated Intermunicipal Cooperation Agreement with the Authority, the other Member Municipalities, and the Stroud Township Sewer Authority (solely in its capacity as owner and operator of the Stroud Collection System with no right, title, or interest in the governance or assets of the Authority) (the "Second Supplement"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has the legal authority to enact ordinances for Pocono Township.

The Second Supplement, in substantially the form attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit B, and incorporated herein by reference with such changes, insertions, and variations therein as the officers of the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Pocono, upon advice of the Solicitor of Pocono Township, shall approve, such approval to be conclusively evidenced by the execution thereof, is hereby approved and adopted, but shall only become binding and effective in accordance with its terms if and when the Authority, the other Member Municipalities and the Stroud Township Sewer Authority, by appropriate official action, all approve, adopt, authorize, execute and deliver the same. The Chair or Vice Chair and the Secretary or Assistant Secretary of the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Pocono are hereby authorized to execute duplicate, counterpart originals of said Second Supplement and deliver the same to the other parties to the Second Supplement.

Section 5. The proper officers of the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Pocono are hereby authorized and directed to join with the proper officers of the other Member Municipalities to execute the proposed Articles of Amendment to the Existing Articles, and to file said Articles of Amendment, together with a certified copy of this Ordinance and required proof of publication with the Secretary of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and to do, execute, and perform any and all acts and things necessary or appropriate to effect said Articles of Amendment.

Section 6. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the **Board of Commissioners of the Township of Pocono** that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7. All ordinances and resolutions, and parts thereof, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or rescinded, but only insofar as the same are in direct conflict or directly inconsistent with this Ordinance.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after enactment.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF THE BRODHEAD CREEK REGIONAL AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Brodhead Creek Regional Authority (formerly the Stroudsburg Municipal Authority) (the "Authority") was created and exists under the Municipality Authorities Act (the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania approved May 2, 1945, P.L. 382, as continued by an Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania approved June 19, 2001, P.L. 22 (53 Pa. Cons. Stat. §§ 5601, et

seq.)) (the "Act") for the purpose, inter alia, of construction, ownership, and operation of water systems serving the Borough of Stroudsburg ("Stroudsburg") and the Townships of Hamilton ("Hamilton"), Pocono ("Pocono"), Smithfield ("Smithfield") and Stroud ("Stroud" and, together with Stroudsburg, Hamilton, Pocono and Smithfield, the "Member Municipalities") as well as Paradise and Tobyhanna Townships, and owning, operating, and maintaining a wastewater treatment system providing treatment services to all or portions of Stroudsburg, Hamilton, Pocono, Stroud (through the Stroud Township Sewer Authority); and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act of December 19, 1976, P.L. 1158, No. 177, as amended, codified at 53 Pa. Cons. Stat. §§2301, et seq., provides that two or more local governments in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania may jointly cooperate in the exercise or performance of their respective governmental functions, powers or responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the governing boards of the BCRA and the Borough of Stroudsburg the Townships of Hamilton, Pocono, Smithfield, and Stroud and the Stroudsburg Municipal Authority entered into an Intermunicipal Cooperation Agreement dated as of July 1, 2005 (the "Original Cooperation Agreement") in order to memorialize the terms of the reimbursement and certain additional terms and conditions for converting the BCRA to make it a joint authority and its operation as a joint authority; and

WHEREAS, the governing boards of the BCRA, the Member Municipalities, and the Stroud Township Sewer Authority (solely in its capacity as owner and operator of the Stroud Collection System with no right, title, or interest in the governance or assets of the BCRA) also previously entered into an Amended and Restated Intermunicipal Cooperation Agreement dated as of May 1, 2010 (the "Amended and Restated Cooperation Agreement") in order to amend and restate the Original Cooperation Agreement in order to agree to additional terms and conditions for ownership, development, and operation of the wastewater system and the execution and delivery of individual treatment agreement to better define the relationships among the parties thereto; and

WHEREAS, the governing boards of the BCRA, the Member Municipalities, and the Stroud Township Sewer Authority (solely in its capacity as owner and operator of the Stroud Collection System with no right, title, or interest in the governance or assets of the BCRA) also previously entered into a First Supplement to the Amended and Restated Intermunicipal Cooperation Agreement dated as of November 1, 2010 (the "First Supplement") (the Original Cooperation Agreement, the Amended and Restated Agreement, and the First Supplement are collectively referred to as the "Cooperation Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the first tri-annual meeting was held on April 7, 2014 between the Member Municipalities and the Collection System Owners, wherein amendments to the Cooperation Agreement were proposed and agreed upon to be codified in a Second Supplement; and

WHEREAS, the Authority was first incorporated as the Stroudsburg Municipal Authority, on November 30, 1953, which its Articles of Incorporation were amended in 1968 and 1984, both of which to extend the term of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Articles of Incorporation were further amended in 2005 by the Member Municipalities in order to convert the Authority from a single municipal authority owned by the Borough of Stroudsburg to a joint authority adding Hamilton, Pocono, Stroud, and Smithfield Townships; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Articles of Incorporation were amended again by the Member Municipalities effective May 18, 2010 ("Existing Articles"), which expanded the powers and purposes of the Authority, authorized the owning, maintaining, and operation of sewer and sewer systems, including collection and treatment plants, extended the term of existence, and set forth terms and conditions for appointment of the Authority's Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, the Member Municipalities desire to extend the term of the Authority to a full fifty (50) years as authorized by the Act as well as update the listing of current members and their terms thereby necessitating an amendment to the Existing Articles as amended by the 2017 Articles of Amendment; and

WHEREAS, the Authority proposes to amend its Articles of Incorporation to extend its existence until January 1, 2067, update the listing of existing Board Members and their terms, amend its registered address, and thereafter restate the remaining Articles as approved in the 2017 Articles of Amendment;

WHEREAS, the Authority proposes to enter into a Second Supplement to the Amended and Restated Intermunicipal Cooperation Agreement with the Member Municipalities (the "Second Supplement") in order to: (1) establish amendments to the Authority's Articles and update Board structure; (2) clarify the Rules and Regulations regarding prohibited discharges; (3) reserving Section 5.9; (4) modify the definition of "Water Service Area"; (5) modify the definition of "Wastewater Service Area"; (6) clarify obligation of Collection System Owners to adopt Authority Wastewater Rules and Regulations; (7) update Section 6.10.1(i)-(v), to wit: i) establish obligation to maintain Municipal Act 167 Plans to DRBC's NPSPCP requirements; ii) establish procedures to be followed for new connections in Wastewater Municipalities; (8) delete condition 2N of existing Section 6.10.2(i) and (ii) and re-referencing clauses (i)-(v) in Section 6.10.2(ii) to clauses (i)-(iv); (9) delete Section 6.10.3 of Original Cooperation Agreement which section was added by Section 1.10 of the First Supplement; (10) establish Tobyhanna Township as part of the Pocono Collection System and identifying the sewer treatment district; (11) add a new Section 6.11 to clarify and define requests to expand and extend wastewater service areas; (12) change address and contact information for Pocono Township; (13) identify new Ordinances and Resolutions to establish change of Articles and execution of Second Supplement; (14) establish a new revised set of standard Definitions to be utilized in the Cooperation Agreement and wastewater treatment agreements as set forth in new Exhibit J; (15) provide for standard abbreviations of words in Exhibit K; (16) clarify that all terms in Second Supplement shall carry the same meanings as the Original Cooperation Agreement and the First Supplement unless modified therein; (17) ratify all other terms of the Original Cooperation Agreement and the First Supplement which were not modified by the Second Supplement; (18) authorize counterpart signatures; (19) interpret the use of sections and subsections throughout the Cooperation Agreement.
