Recreation Committee

Be a part of the vision to develop the parks and open spaces of Pocono Township. As an advisory committee to the BOC, the objective is to provide new ideas that can improve the recreational opportunities for all.

Planning Commission

Its primary role within the Township is to serve as advisors to the Board of Commissioners. It provides recommendations on a wide variety of planning and land development related proposals, including but not limited to re-zonings, ordinance amendments, plans and studies, and land development. It is also responsible for reviewing applications for subdivisions and land developments with respect to their compliance with the Township's Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance.

Zoning Hearing Board

It is a quasi-judicial body that conducts legally binding hearings and renders decisions on appeals, variances, and special exceptions to the township's zoning ordinances.

Civil Service Commission

The Civil Service Commission is a six- member body that has three regular members and three alternative members. As part of the First-Class Township Code, Pocono Township is required to have a Civil Service Commission which deals with various aspects of the police department's hiring, promotion, and termination process.
